The apartments and group home offer accessible living features such as lowered counter heights, roll-in showers, and widened doorways for people who use wheelchairs. Other adaptations are also available for people who have disabilities. The society will also help clients locate the services of an attendant if they do not already have one. The income of any person living with the client, other than that of a certified attendant, will be considered when determining income status. Pets are also permitted in the apartment buildings, but not in the group home. At the group home, Independent Living Skills Training is provided for residents by program aides and by volunteer instructors from Pasadena Community College. **Fee:** Varies.

Eligibility: Low-income adults 18 years + with physical or developmental disabilities.
