Chronically Homeless Person – HUD defines a chronically homeless person as “an unaccompanied homeless individual with a disabling condition who has either been continuously homeless for a year or more **OR** has had at least four (4) episodes of homelessness in the past three (3) years.” To be considered chronically homeless, a person must have been on the streets or in an emergency shelter (i.e. **NOT** in a transitional housing) during these stays.

⊗ **Maximum Annual Income Restrictions Apply**

⊗ **Applicants will be called in for interviews based on their position on the Special Needs Wait List. New pre-application NOT required if your client is already on the waiting list.**

⊗ **Must meet all eligibility criteria at time of Housing Authority interview**
