Provides developmentally and culturally appropriate child care services to children of eligible parents. **Eligibility:** Children must be between the ages of 2 and 5 to attend child development. Children ages 5 to 12 may participate in the Before & After School enrichment programs. **Fee:** A family with a low income pays a weekly fee as determined from the eligibility fee schedule issued by the California Department of Education. No fee will be collected from families whose children enrolled because of need for child protective services or the family's gross monthly income is below 50% the State Median Income.

Offers Early Childhood Education: The center provides child care for college students. The program for children includes lessons in art, science, music, dramatic play, language arts, motor development, and nutrition. Students may use the service up to 10 hours per day, with a minimum of a four-hour block of time, two days per week. Post-secondary Education: The program offers a college credit course entitled Preschool Child Techniques, which enables parents to gain a better understanding of their children through observations and interaction. The minimum age is 33 months to kindergarten entrance age. At the Pacific Coast Campus Center, the minimum age is 24 months. Foster Family Services: The program provides foster family services for people in Los Angeles County. Services include instruction for emancipation of minors, including at risk youth and workshops for foster parents and kinship caregivers. The instruction for emancipation of minors is targeted to youth, ages 14 to 18 who are managing their own financial affairs, whose income is derived from activities not considered criminal, who are willing to live apart from their parents or guardians with their consent, and who want to petition the court to be considered over the age of majority. The structured classes run for about 6 weeks in length. The workshops for foster parents and kinship caregivers cover a wide range of topics that relate to parenting skills development and foster care issues. There are no geographic restrictions. **Eligibility:** Students with children between the ages of 2-5 years. **Fee:** \$20, nonrefundable registration fee for fall and spring. \$10 non-refundable registration fee for the summer.

Offers Youth services- Services include alternative education; continuation high schools; crisis intervention for gang-related problems; extended day care programs for at risk youth and gang programs for children, ages 8 through 12; Family life education- Services include parenting skills development and technical assistance for youth services; Substance abuse services- Services include alcohol abuse counseling and drug abuse counseling; individual and group counseling is available. Counseling also addresses problems related to gangs and AIDS.

Eligibility: Application process, services given on a need basis (for example at risk youth would be first provided youth services). **Fee:** There are fixed fees for services; parenting skills development is \$5 per class, no fees for substance abuse services, no fee for youth services, fixed fee for youth camp.
