A comprehensive educational program for adults and credit-deficient high school students. Applicants under age 18 must have a referral from their high school counselor and be within two months of their 18th birthday or second semester seniors who will not graduate. Concurrent high school/LBSA enrollment is also permitted. Enrolling students must score at least at the ninth grade reading level on the TABE assessment, or they will be referred to the Literacy Center for remediation before beginning to earn high school credits.

Graduation requirements are similar to those of a comprehensive high school. Students must maintain 80% attendance in teacher-directed classes and complete at least 10 credits at LBSA. FEE: \$20 materials fee, no charge for basic education classes, some courses require purchase of textbooks and other supplies. Call/visit the website for more information.
